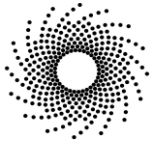
## WARNING CONCERNING COPYRIGHT RESTRICTIONS

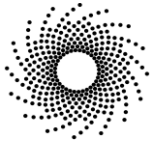
