
DID YOU KNOW?

Brooklynite Susan Smith McKinney Steward (1847-1918) was the first African American woman in New York state to receive a medical degree.

In the 19th century, she helped found the Memorial Hospital, a Brooklyn institution that catered to the medical needs of women and children, and run by an all-female staff.




